

INTERESTING COMMENTS FROM GREAT BRITAIN'S PRINCE PHILIP

[Taken from BBC.com Radio 4 Programme] 2 January 2016, Great Britain's Prince Philip gave an interview to the BBC's Radio 4, discussing various topics, including global climate change. Just to relay some of his comments, related to engineering as well as some factoids:

- "Everything that wasn't invented by God was invented by an engineer."
- "Engineering had contributed to the post-war recovery and would help solve future problems."
- "In 1976 Prince Philip initiated the Fellowship of Engineering, now the Royal Academy of Engineering, which promotes excellence and education in the field."
- "But somehow or other that balance to try to fit as many people on to this globe as comfortably as possible without them doing too much damage—I think ultimately it's going to be engineers who are going to decide that."
- Finally, "He said it was 'curious' that there was no Nobel Prize for engineering. He suggested it may be because of a historical divide between scientists and engineers. There was 'a certain amount of jealousy and a certain amount of anxiety' as to who was 'better', he said."
